1. Rural Access Improvement and Decentralization Project (RAID) is being implemented in 30 districts under additional financing of the World Bank IDA Grant no H-525-NEP and Credit No. 4664. A part of this additional finance is to be used to enhance the livelihood of the vulnerable communities along with the road sub-projects by conducting the skill development trainings. Hence, the project wants to organize livelihood enhancement training and support programs in eight (8) districts recently. The project wants to conduct the training program through local non-governmental organization (NGOs).
2. The NGO (s) interested to conduct respective trainings is/are informed to collect the Terms of Reference (TOR) from the PCU during office hour up to Chaitra 10, 2067. The NGO interested in the training can submit the financial proposal in coordination with local NGOs working at the district level.
3. The NGO (s) is/are informed to submit their respective financial proposal up to Chaitra 11, 2067. The interested NGO (s) should submit the experience of completion certificate of at least one similar types of training.
4. The late submission of the FP shall not be considered.
5. If the collection and submission of the ToR fall on the public holiday, those activities will be furnished on the next office day during office hour.
6. The NGO (s) will get ToR upon the endorsement of a request letter to PCU along with registration certificate, renewed letter and audit report for current fiscal year 2067/2068.
7. The detail information are stated in ToR. Any further information required can be obtained from PCU during office hours.
